**TOURNAMENT RULES**  
**OSUSBC YOUTH STATE TOURNAMENT**  
**TEAM – DOUBLES – SINGLES – ALL EVENTS**

1. Tournament is open to all USBC Youth Members.
2. Bowlers in different average divisions may bowl together.
3. All entries will be entered as received per squad. Please include email or phone number in case squads need to be adjusted.
4. **All entry forms must be complete, and payment included. All entries MUST have the recap sheet(s) for all bowlers.**
5. Handicap will be 90% of 230.
6. **ENTERING AVERAGE: (RECAP SHEET MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM)**
  - Current league average after 21 games; or
  - The highest certified league average as of the end of the previous winter season, provided they have bowled 21 games, whichever is higher; or
  - If a bowler does not have a current or previous league average, they must use 230.
  - Handicap is 90% of 230.

7. USBC rules and regulations will govern tournaments except Rule 322 – No absentee scores will be allowed. USBC eligibility rules will be strictly enforced.
8. Falsification of any entry will result in automatic disqualification of ENTIRE entry, no refund.
9. A bowler may only bowl SINGLES ONCE during tournament. A bowler may bowl multiple Doubles and Team multiple times. If bowler options for SCRATCH SINGLES, the score from their single event will be used for both events.
10. Check-in will be 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
11. Dress code: Appropriate attire is required. Clothing without rips and/or tears, no tank-tops or spaghetti straps. Shirts with sleeves. No inappropriate graphics or language. Matching apparel encouraged.
12. **NO PARENTS IN THE SETTEE AREA.** The bowler may come to you and ask questions, but do not hold up the game.
13. Scholarships will be given in Team, Doubles, Singles, All Events and Scratch Singles, based on 1 out of 4, or major portion thereof, entered in each division. All scholarships will be placed in the recipient's SMART account.
14. The Tournament Director has the final decision on all tournament matters.
