All entrants must be at least 50 years of age by July 1, 2027, and be a current member of the Oregon State USBC.

Current members of any Professional Bowlers Association will NOT be permitted to bowl in this tournament.

There are six separate classifications of qualifying based on age as of July 1, 2027, for both the Open and Women's Divisions.

See the front of the entry form for age classification. Be sure to circle the division, Open or Women's, in which you will be competing, and check the appropriate box for your age classification as of July 1, 2027. Qualifying consists of two 3-game blocks, for a total of six games, with handicap used to determine standings.

Entrants may re-enter this tournament, but may cash only once.

All games may be bowled in one day or over any two days of the tournament.

Averages: Entering average will be determined in the following order:

1. Highest Standard/House average of 21 games or more for the 2025–26 season, including summer. If none, then
2. Highest Standard/House average of 21 games or more for the 2024–25 season, including summer. If none, then
3. Entrant will use an entering average of 210.

If the only average available is a Sport or Challenge League average of 21 games or more, it will be adjusted in accordance with USBC Rule 201.

Rule 319a applies. If a bowler has a current average of 21 games or more is 10 pins or more higher than the entering average for this tournament, it must be reported and used for the tournament.

It is each bowler's responsibility to ensure average accuracy.

Handicap will be based on 90 percent of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 for each game.

The highest 6-game total with handicap in each age classification will receive a paid entry into the 2027 USBC National Senior Championship.

The winner will also receive a Championship Shirt and reimbursement of up to \$200 for travel expenses, upon completion of the trip and upon furnishing OSUSBC with receipts for those expenses.

In the event of a tie after 6 games of qualifying, the winner will be determined by the highest single-game score with handicap.

If a tie still exists, the next highest game with handicap will be used, and so on until a winner is determined.

The prize ratio is 1 in 8 entries in each age classification.

Any situation not covered by these rules shall be governed by USBC Tournament Rules.

Each entrant hereby agrees that the Oregon State USBC, its officers, or agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if the entrant is prevented from bowling in the tournament because of delay, unexpected but necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament caused by national or state emergencies, fire, lockout, labor difficulties, or any cause beyond the control of the USBC and the Senior Qualifying Tournament.

All entrants give express permission to the Oregon State USBC to use their name, photo, or likeness in any form of media without compensation.
